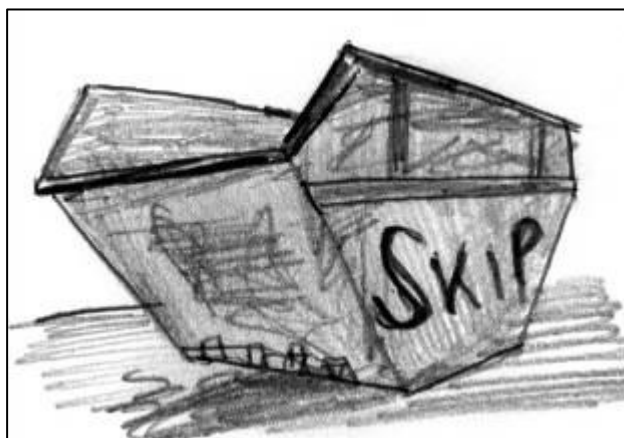


## Balcony Spring Clean – Saturday 11 March 9 am to 12 noon
