

The Parish of Greenford Magna

The Parish is served by the ancient Church of The Holy Cross, Greenford (earliest known Rector 1183) and Holy Cross New Church, opened in 1941, in Ferrymead Gardens. Services take place regularly in both Churches and the congregation welcomes new people to all events and activities.

Normal Sunday Services

8.00am Said Mass in the Old Church

9.30am The Parish Mass in the New Church

Evening services are held occasionally, and for details of these please refer to the public notice boards and the weekly newsletter 'Stop Press' which will also detail any changes.

Midweek Services

These vary from time to time. Please check the Notice Boards and 'Stop Press' for weekly changes. Holy Days and major festivals are also celebrated by services during the week.

Holy Baptism

Applicants should normally live within the Parish borders (not just Greenford generally), and attend the Service in the first instance for information on dates etcetera. Infant Baptism is administered at the Parish Mass at 9.30am on ten designated Sundays every year. Adult Baptism and Confirmation is normally administered once a year, after preparation, in the summer. Holy Matrimony

To qualify for marriage at Holy Cross one of the applicants should normally reside within the Parish borders or be enrolled on the Electoral Roll of the Church. It is Parish policy to marry those who are divorced with a former spouse living if one of the applicants meets the legal qualifications.
