8pm in the Holy Cross New Church

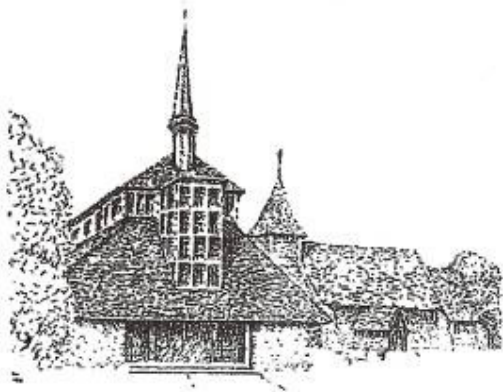
