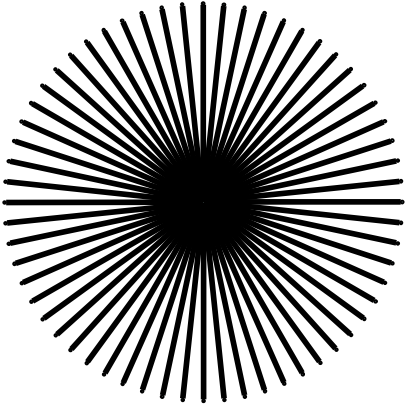


Holy Cross Sixty Club



This is our very own lottery, which **you** can join at any time, (although most members join in May), which costs **just £12**. For this sum, you are not only helping Holy Cross Church, but also have a chance of winning cheque prizes.

Each month $\frac{1}{2}$ of the income goes out in cheques prize(s) – an agreed minimum of £30. Alternate months, the winning cheque(s) are 1 x £30 or 3 x £10. **With 60 members, £360. can be raised each year.**

There were 4 new numbers taken up last year. (there are always spare numbers for new members).

The Club needs 60 members to make the expected profit, as we are committed to giving out £30 in cheque prizes, every month. Sadly, the subscriptions came in so slowly last year that I delayed the first draw until October. Please pay up as soon as you can to enable the club to run to schedule.

Last year, the fund purchased 2 trolleys for the storage of all our tables.
