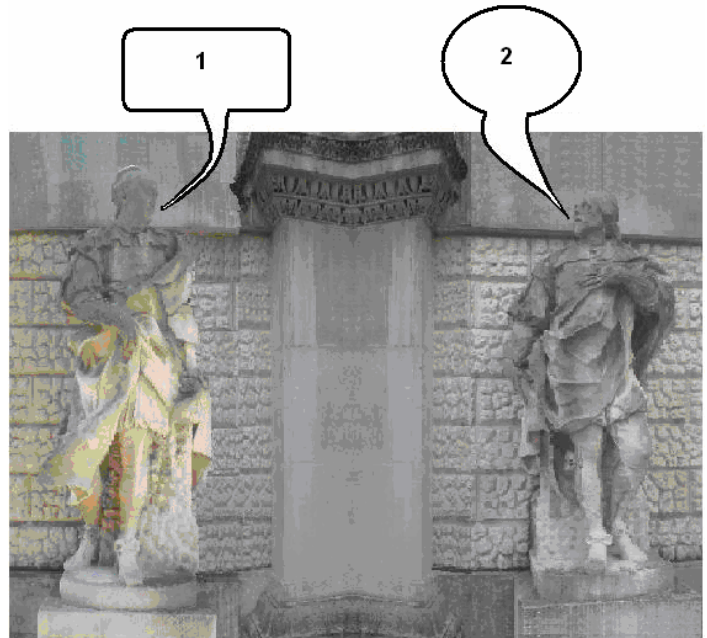
Well done to all the teams that took part and congratulations to Team 187 (Neil, Marion and Malcolm) for winning this year's Holy Cross Treasure Hunt.
