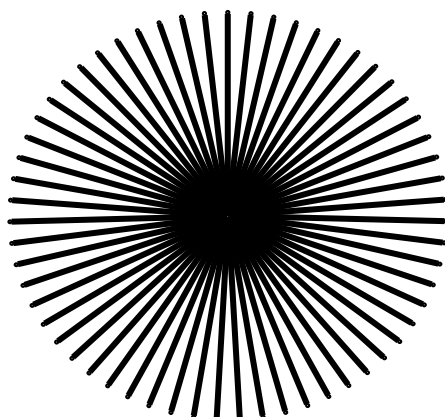


THE HOLY CROSS SIXTY CLUB
