

Holy Cross Sunday, 2011 New Banner for Holy Cross Church



On Sunday, 18th September, 2011, a new Holy Cross banner was dedicated on our Feast of Title, Holy Cross Sunday. It was the gift of former Churchwarden, Ray Allen, now of Lincoln, and was made by a mother and daughter team, that of Judith Inder and Maggie Bannister.

The design follows that of the previous banner quite closely with the addition of the Latin words

Stat crux dum volvitur orbis

The words are normally translated into English as "The Cross stands firm as the world turns." The swirling motif around the cross expresses the sentiment of the words effectively.

The Holy Cross banner will join the new Mothers' Union Banner which Maggie and Judith made two years ago.

The whole congregation expressed their gratitude to Maggie and Judith for their needlework and the banner was dedicated by the Revd. Richard Lloyd Morgan, Chaplain of King's College, Cambridge, who was our special guest on the day.

We now hope to take the banner to various places such as St. Paul's Cathedral and on the St. Alban's Pilgrimage in June 2012. We will be proud to carry the banner as we represent Holy Cross Church and as we "Lift high the cross, the love of Christ proclaim, till all the world adore his sacred name."
